

# Hill Classical Middle School, Uniform Requirements, 2006-07

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**Important Information: Hill's Uniforms are 3 piece uniforms (tops, bottoms, sweatshirts)**

- Uniforms must be worn all day long, as long as a student is on the Hill campus (no changing at school)
- Students who do not abide by the dress code must change into “loaner” clothes and will receive detention, points, suspension, and/or other disciplinary action. Loaner clothes must be returned to Hill.
- Students who bring inappropriate outerwear and/or accessories will have items confiscated until retrieved by a parent.
- Uniform assistance: If a student cannot afford to purchase the required uniforms, help is available. Please contact Mrs. Villacorta at (562) 598-7611Ex 604
- Uniform donations: We gladly accept used and new uniforms for students who have difficulty obtaining uniforms.
- Fall Photo Day is a uniform-required day. (September)
- Spring Photo Day (April), and the last two days of school (June) are Free-Dress days. Students must abide by the District Dress Code.
- Sun-Protective Headgear may be worn, with prior approval by the principal at parent’s written request (see Front Office for description of special sun-protective headgear—includes neck and ear flaps)

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**Shirts****Required:**

- Solid white, collared, logo-free (or Hill logo)
- Solid white turtlenecks (must extend to middle of neck)
- Undershirts must be plain white (**only 1 may be worn**)
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times (except at lunch), and **must be long enough to be tucked in.**

**Not Allowed:**

- Colored shirts under white collared shirts, only plain white shirts are acceptable
- PE Shirts under collared shirts
- Plaid, striped, etc. not allowed at all
- Pajama tops
- Shirts knotted or tied at the back

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**Bottoms****Required:**

- Solid navy or beige (khaki) pants, shorts, skirts, jumpers, skorts (no stripes, patterns, fades)
- Must be hemmed (at least to mid-thigh)
- Must fit at leg/inseam and/or crotch
- Shorts/skirts must be no shorter than mid-thigh (tip of fingers at sides)

**Not Allowed:**

- Sagging, pants dragging on floor, or pants tucked into socks, knotted or banded at the bottom
- Denim and/or denim look-alikes
- Athletic (sweat) pants of any kind, including nylon, fleece, velour
- Pajama bottoms

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**Sweatshirts & Other Outerwear****Required:**

- Pull-over or zip up sweatshirts, cardigan sweaters, vests, windbreakers must be solid navy and logo-free or they may be white, gray or khaki with a Hill logo
- Heavy winter coats or raincoats must be worn OVER an appropriate sweatshirt only outside during cold/rainy weather and may be any color

**Not Allowed:**

- Plaid, striped, colored, or oversized shirts, sweatshirts, sweaters
- Denim jackets of any color
- Hoods (May be worn outside the buildings only)
- Heavy winter coats/raincoats (May be worn outside the classrooms only)

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**Accessories****Acceptable:**

- Belts, if worn, can be any solid color with plain logo free or initial free buckles
- Socks/tights must be solid colored and logo free
- Shoes must be closed-toe and cover entire foot and heels are not to exceed 2 inches
- Neckties, scarves. if worn, must be solid navy or khaki.
- Gloves outside only on cold days

**Not Allowed:**

- Initial buckles, logo belts or buckles, belt tails longer than 4 inches from belt loop, chains from loop/pockets or spiked belts
- Sandals, mules, house slippers, etc.
- Hats, do-rags, bandanas, sweatbands and athletic headbands (plain navy, white, or beige logo-free hair-bands are OK)
- Large chains or medallions worn outside of shirt

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**Spirit Days and Other Special Days**

- Fridays: Personal Best shirts, Hill Husky T-shirts, Hill Club, or Hill Athletic Team shirts w/uniform bottoms.
- Game Days: Hill Team jerseys (w/uniform bottoms) and Hill Cheer outfits are OK
- Dance Days: Students can wear BLUE jeans w/Uniform tops, and must wear through entire dance.
- Dress-Up Days: See guidelines for each particular day (Pajama Day, Western Day, etc.)
